

## Cookie Policy

This policy applies to cookies in Quarashi Network websites and applications operated by Quarashi Network

Cookies are used for the following purposes:

- operation of the site,
- analysis of the behavior of site visitors,
- for advertising.

This policy is supplemented by the Quarashi Network Privacy Policy which you can find on the website.

### 2. What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file, consisting of letters and numbers, that will be stored on a computer, mobile terminal, or other equipment of a user accessing the Internet. The cookie is installed by the request made by the user's terminal to a Quarashi Network server or to a third party server.

### 3. What are cookies used for?

These files mainly make it possible to recognize the user's terminal and present the content in a relevant way, adapted to the user's preferences.

Cookies provide users with a pleasant browsing experience and support Quarashi Network efforts to provide more user-friendly services, eg: - online privacy preferences or relevant advertising. They are also used in the preparation of aggregate anonymous statistics that help us understand how a user benefits from our web pages, allowing us to improve their structure and content, without allowing the user to be personally identified.

### 4. What cookies do we use?

We use two types of cookies: per session and fixed. Per session cookies are temporary files that remain in the user's terminal until the end of the session or the application is closed. Fixed cookies remain on the user's terminal for a period determined by the cookie parameters or until they are manually deleted by the user.

### 5. How are cookies used by this site?

A visit to this site may place the following types of cookies:

- cookies strictly necessary for the operation of the site

- analysis cookies
- advertising cookies

Cookies and / or similar technologies strictly necessary are essential for the proper functioning of the site, being set on your device when accessing the site or following the actions performed on the site, as appropriate. You can set your browser to block cookies, but in this case certain sections of the site will not work properly.

#### 6. Do cookies contain personal data?

Cookies do not in themselves require personal information in order to be used and, in many cases, do not personally identify internet users. However, there are situations when personal data may be collected through the use of cookies to facilitate certain functionalities for the user or to offer the user an experience more adapted to his preferences. Such data is encrypted in a way that makes it impossible for unauthorized persons to access it.

#### 7. Block cookies

If you wish to block cookies, some features of the site will be disabled, and this may lead to certain malfunctions or errors in the use of our site.

If you agree to these limitations and wish to block cookies, please follow the instructions below: Most browsers are set to accept cookies by default, but you can change the settings to block some or all cookies.

#### 8. Administering cookie placement preferences

In general, an application used to access web pages allows you to save cookies and / or similar technologies on the terminal by default. These settings can be changed so that the automatic administration of cookies is blocked by the web browser or the user is informed every time cookies are sent to his terminal.

Detailed information about the possibilities and ways of managing cookies can be found in the settings area of the application (web browser). Limiting the use of cookies may affect certain functionalities of the website.

#### 9. Security and privacy issues

In general, browsers have integrated privacy settings that provide different levels of acceptance of cookies, the period of validity and automatic deletion after the user has visited a particular site.

Other security issues related to cookies:

- Customize your browser settings for cookies to reflect a comfortable level of cookie security for you.
- If you are the only person using your computer, you can set long expiration dates for storing your browsing history and personal access data if you wish.

- If you share access to your computer, you can consider setting your browser to clear individual browsing data each time you close your browser. This is a way to access the sites that place cookies and to delete any visit information at the end of the browsing session.

These third parties may set and use cookies and / or similar technologies on websites and applications operated by Quarashi Network, as well as on websites and applications other than those operated by Quarashi Network.
